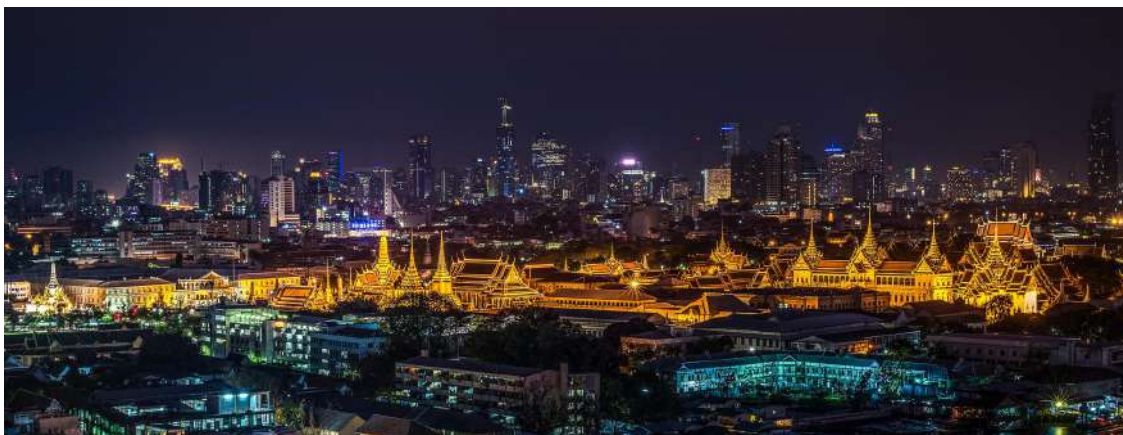

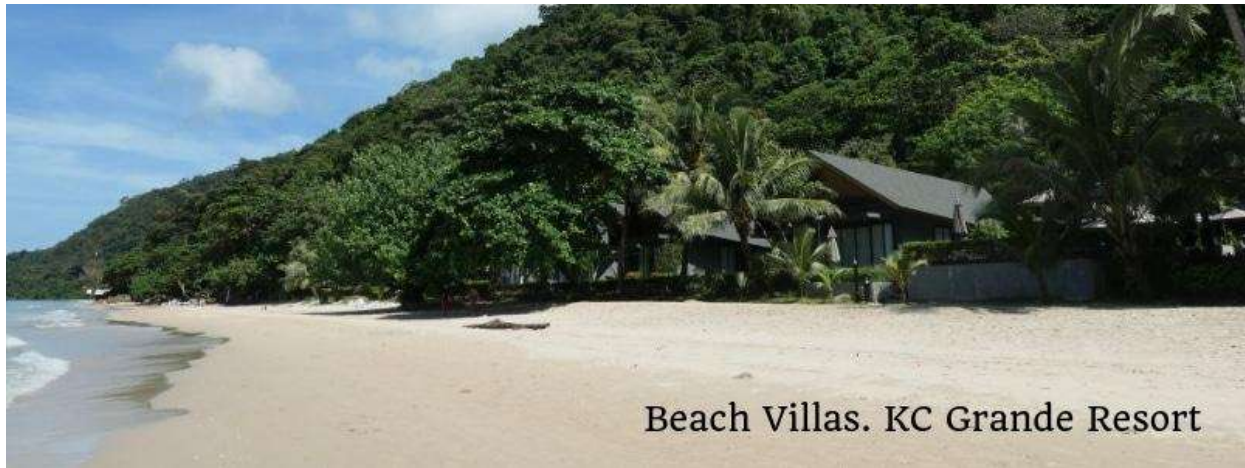

Koh Chang is located inside Thailand's marine national park with about 60 islands and about 16 km² of coral reef. Located in the province of Trat, in the east of the country, on the border with Cambodia. The park was established in 1982 as the 45th national park in Thailand. It covers an area of 650 km², including 458 km² of the waters of the Gulf of Thailand. Classified by the IUCN as a protected area with coral reef



Bang Bao- traditional fishing village

An interesting place is the floating village near Bang Bao Pier on the southern tip of Koh Chang.



Wat Salak Petch - Temple

The temple to visit on Koh Chang is Wat Salak Petch. Small compared to most other temples but worth a visit. Contrary to the traditional Thai style of architecture, the temple is colorful with two large welcoming snakes on the railings.



Mangrove Walkaway

Not far from Wat Salak Petch there is a mangrove forest. It became a tourist area when a walkway was built over the surrounding woods to give a bird's eye view of the area. The walkway is especially great for photos and is usually deserted

Chiang Mai (05 - 07.01)

Chiang Mai is a land of misty mountains and colorful hill tribes, a playground for seasoned travelers and a delight for adventurers. Chiang Mai is 700 km north of Bangkok, set in a verdant valley on the banks of the Ping River. The city was founded in 1296 as the capital of the ancient Lanna Kingdom and it still proudly wears its distinctive culture and long history for all to see. However, it's now a place where the past and the present seamlessly merge with modern buildings standing side by side with venerable temples.

Chiang Mai Old Town

If you want to discover the majority of Chiang Mai's attractions and tourist sites, you should go to the old town. There, you will find most of the main temples (more details below), street markets and museums



Doi Suthep

Doi Suthep is the regal mountain overlooking the city of Chiang Mai from the northwest. It is home to Wat Phra That Doi Suthep, an awe-inspiring temple that is crowned by an elaborate chedi, 24 metres tall and gold plated from top to bottom. It gleams like a northern star from the heights of the mountain. The temple is one of the most historically and spiritually significant places in Thailand and is an impressive embodiment of the Lanna culture, with its origins dating back almost 700 years.
